The college takes its inspiration from the famous lines of the song '*Biswar Sande Sande Mahandane Anande*' written by Kalaguru Bishnu Prasad Rabha, the mentor of Assamese society and a leader of the common people –

A higher educational institution was established in the heart of Orang Charali in 1990 by some of the economically weak but ever conscious and far sighted people of Orang with the help of public donations in the name of revered personality of Assam, Bishnu Prasad Rabha, who is regarded as the mentor of culture and father of socio-economic revolution in Assam. The Kalaguru Bishnu Rabha Degree College has emerged as one of the leading educational institution imparting higher education to thousands of students belonging to different caste and communities and specially the Tribal and Non-Tribals covering the vast area of the undivided Darrang as well as neighbouring Sonitpur District. The college was in a venture stage till 31st December 2020 and was brought under the category of Provincialization by Government of Assam with effect from 01-01-2021. Till then, it was fully managed by the Governing Body. Despite several economic and social hazards, the college is rendering its valuable service in the field of education to the poor and needy students as the area it covers is mostly economically and geographically backward area ranging from Indo-Bhutan, Assam-Arunachal Pradesh Border to the *Char-Chapari* area in South. The College is making a rapid progress in the academic field with better performance of the students in the subsequent examinations held by affiliating University. It tends to be economically self-sufficient and literally a full-fledged institution by dint of its competent staff. The College is accredited with 'B' Grade by National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC) in its first Cycle of Assessment held in 2023 and has a vision and mission to raise its level to the utmost level in the forthcoming years.

PHYSICAL FACILITIES AVAILABLE IN THE COLLEGE:

1. RFID BASED DIGITAL LIBRARY-

The Library of **Kalaguru Bishnu Rabha Degree College** is **RFID Based Digital Library** that makes the access of books for the students easier and has around **18000 books and 53 peer reviewed journals** and subscribed magazines. The library has both text books and reference books in different languages.

2. PSYCHOLOGICAL LABORATORY:

The College has a well-equipped psychological laboratory for facilitating the students of Education.

3. ICT ENABLED CLASSROOMS:

The college has already introduced the ICT enabled Classrooms and upgraded many of its classrooms to ICT enabled. The faculty members of the college also use additional resources from internet using their mobile technology to help the students. The College has already introduced ICT based classrooms.

4. LANGUAGE LABORATORY:

The college has already set up a Language Laboratory with the help of BTR Government from the Session 2024-2025 for the students to acquire practical knowledge on Spoken English and other languages.

5. COMPUTER AND INTERNET FACILITIES:

The college offers 6 Months Certificate Course on Computer Applications and has a separate computer lab for the student learners with around 55 computers for practical classes with a seating arrangement for 90 students in Theory classes. It also has ISP BSNL Broadband Connection in the College with 100MBPS permanent internet facility.

6. SANITATION

The College has separate Sanitation Facilities for Male and Female Students & Teaching -Non-Teaching Staff.

7. DRINKING WATER FACILITIES

The College provides pure drinking water facilities for its students. It also has implanted pure cold drinking water facilities for its students as well as Teaching and Non-Teaching.

8. KALAGURU BISHNU RABHA DEGREE COLLEGE OUTDOOR STADIUM:

The College has a separate Outdoor Stadium for facilitating students with various games and sports events constructed from the UGC allocation of fund covering an area of more than 4 Acres of Land.

9. KALAGURU BISHNU RABHA DEGREE COLLEGE INDOOR STADIUM:

The College has an Indoor Stadium constructed within the College campus and indoor sports facilities constructed from the UGC allocation of fund.

10. KALAGURU BISHNU RABHA DEGREE COLLEGE GYMNASIUM

The college also has a well-built gymnasium inside the Indoor Stadium that facilitates both the students and staff of the college.

11. SOLAR POWER ENERGY

The College has a well maintained and fully functional solar power energy supply for 24 hours established in the College campus.

The college has a separate computer Lab to carry out computer courses for the students. The College offers 6 Months Certificate Course on Computer Application.
